Important Notice

- Please note that legalising documents from the Jordanian Consulate only confirms the authenticity of the signature, seal or stamp of the relevant party that legalised the document before us. Thus, it does NOT confirm the authenticity of the underlying document and does NOT authenticate either the signature on the original document or the content of the original document in any way.
- The Consulate reserves all rights to NOT legalise any document in contrary with Jordanian public order and morals.
- Please note that we do NOT legalise any Power of Attorney that contains any kind of authorisation for the purpose of selling lands or properties located outside the borders of “The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan”.

Required Documents

In order to be able to legalise any documents from the Consulate, you first need to legalise your documents by one of the following parties:

Submission of Documents:

No appointment needed

1. In person; between 10:00-13:00
2. By a courier; between 10:00-13:00
3. By post to the following address: (Consulate Section, 6 Upper Phillimore Gardens, London, W8 7HA).

Please make sure to include the below documents:

- The original stamped documents
- a receipt of the payment (To pay online, [click here](#))
- a pre-paid self-addressed special delivery envelope for the sufficient weight.

Required Fees

- £63.20 per stamp for commercial documents
- £10.20 per stamp for personal documents

The fees will be paid onsite by credit or debit card only (except Amex).

Processing Time:

- You can collect your personal documents on the same day.
- You can collect your commercial documents after 3 working days between 14:30-16:00.
